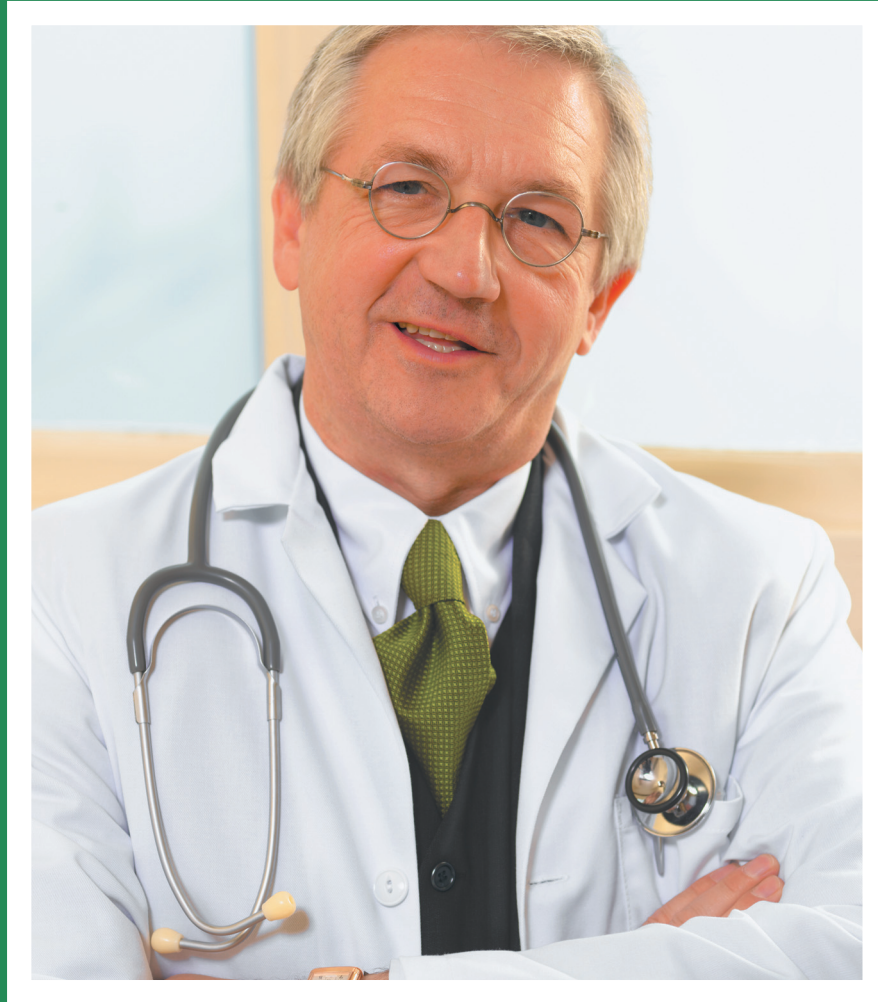


“I can give you excellent medical advice in just three words: take as prescribed.”



Every year, 1.5 million Americans get sick from medication errors—improper doses, dangerous interactions between medicines, allergic reactions. So be sure to:

Take your medication only as prescribed:

be aware of possible side effects, and of what to do if you forget to take a dose. Always take the full prescription—don't stop partway through.

Double-check your medication when you pick it up from the pharmacy—to

see that it's the medicine and dose your doctor ordered. If you have any questions, speak to the pharmacist.
